Edith Wharton wrote this story at her house in Hydes, in the southern French region of Provence. It was her 21st book and first appeared in a New York magazine in 1920. Many people believe that *The Age of Innocence* is her greatest book. It won the Pulitzer Prize – the most important American prize for writing – in 1921. It was the first book written by a woman to win this prize.

She wants us to laugh at it, like Newland does at the beginning of the story.
