Sheep	Ram	Ewe (pronounced 'You')	Lamb
Pig	Boar	Sow	Piglet
Duck	Drake	Duck	Duckling
Hen	Cockerel	Hen	Chick
Goat	Billy	Nanny	Kid
Rabbit	Buck	Doe	Kitten
Horse	Stallion	Mare	Foal



If you want something a bit different, teach the sounds the animals make as an extension exercise.

<i>Animal</i>	<i>Sound</i>	<i>Verb</i>
<i>Cat</i>	<i>Meow!</i>	<i>To meow or to purr (kittens mew)</i>
<i>Dog</i>	<i>Woof-woof! / Bow-wow!</i>	<i>To bark</i>
<i>Cow</i>	<i>Moo!</i>	<i>To moo or to low</i>
<i>Sheep</i>	<i>Baa!</i>	<i>To bleat or to baa</i>
<i>Pig</i>	<i>Oink!</i>	<i>To grunt or to squeal</i>
<i>Duck</i>	<i>Quack!</i>	<i>To quack</i>
<i>Hen</i>	<i>Cluck!</i>	<i>To cluck or to cackle</i>
<i>Goat</i>	<i>Baa!</i>	<i>To bleat</i>
<i>Rabbit</i>	<i>Thump!</i>	<i>To thump or to drum</i>
<i>Horse</i>	<i>Neigh!</i>	<i>To neigh</i>
